RACING EXPERIENCE

2008 RACING SEASON

I have been racing for a total of 6 full years. 2008 was a large transition year for my riding abilities. Coming off one of my most successful seasons in 2007, I moved up to a 250f size bike for 2008. Unfortunately, I had to take the Spring Series off in order to prepare my new bike. For the Fall Series I raced almost every NESC event and continued to improve each weekend. Although my first rides on the bigger bike were rocky, my skills continued to progress as did the season. Throughout the fall of 2008, my major accomplishments included winning the 125 Novice Class on September, 14, being promoted to the 125 Youth B class, earning enough promotional points to make the 125 Amateur class for 2009, and finishing second in the 125 Novice Fall Series Championship.

PLANS FOR 2009

For the 2008 Season I am planning on racing a 2009 KX250f. Once again, I will try my hardest to attend all of the NESC Spring and Fall Series races. Thanks to the promotional points which I earned in 2008, I will be racing the 125 Amateur and 125 Youth B classes. Although the 125 Amateur will be a large step up from the 125 Novice Class, I believe that I am up to the challenge. My goals for 2009 are to be competitive in the 125 Amateur class and to continually improve my skills and get faster throughout the year. By year end, I want to be one of the top competitors in the Amateur class and finish consistently in the Top 10.
